# A piece of history - Slovakia

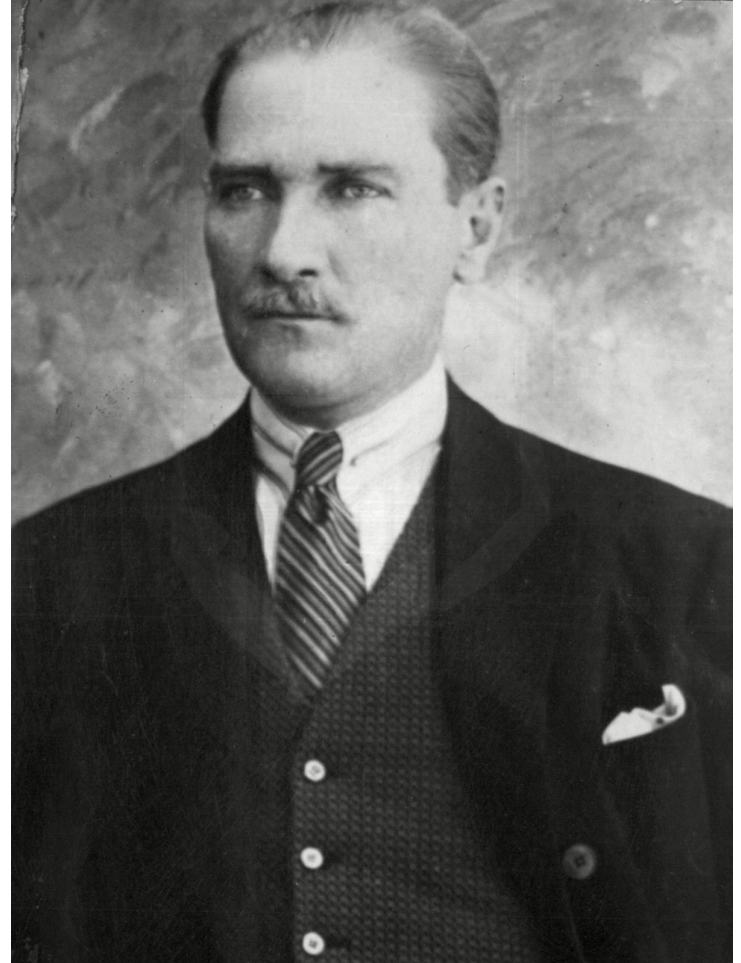
Cyril and Method brought the scripture and faith to Great Moravia, in year 863. The scripture was called a Galgolic alphabet.

# Mountains : France

FRANCE: The Alps :at 4.808 metres ( 15.774 ft )the **Mont Blanc**, on the French Italian border, is the **highest mountain in the Alps** and the highest Western European mountain . Notable towns in the French Alps include Grenoble Annecy Chambéry Evian les Bains and Albertville.





# Mountains - Slovakia

The highest mountain is called Gerlachovský štít (2654 m)

The next one is called Ďumbier (2046 m)

They are both located in The High Tatras  
(Vysoké Tatry) mountain range.



# Mountains : Turkey

There are a lot of mountains in Turkey.

Mount Ararat is the highest, 5137 meters high. It is a volcano situated in the East of the country. It is permanently covered in snow.



# French Rivers

The **Seine river** which goes through Paris, the capital, is the most famous French river. It is 777 km long.

**La Loire** is the longest French river. It is 1012 km long and there are a lot of castles along the Loire : **Les châteaux de la Loire**.



# Slovak Rivers

The longest river in Slovakia is Váh, it's 403 kilometers long. The biggest river is the Danube (Dunaj) - 2850 km long, but only 172 km go through Slovakia. It also creates the Slovak-Austrian border (7,5 km)

# Turkish rivers

The **Kızılırmak**, also known as the **Halys River** is the longest river entirely within Turkey. It is a source of hydroelectric power and is not used for navigation. It is 1350 kilometers long.





# Costumes

## Traditional costume in France (Alsace):

It is good to know that there is not only one **traditional Alsatian costume** but several depending on the place, the time and the religious cultures. For example the catholics wear the red skit called “the kutt” while the protestants wear “rock” a shorter and generally green dress.

# Traditional Turkish costume

Turkish **trousers** or dimije are traditional baggy **trousers** gathered in tightly at the ankle. Men may wear the traditional loose coat, called a jubba, over the şalvar.



# Endemics

There are no specifically French animals but the symbol of France is the **Rooster** which is a popular animal in farms





# Endemics - Slovakia

An endemic is a species or other systematic unit that occurs only in a specific territory and nowhere else. Only its natural occurrence is taken into account. Areas of occurrence of individual endemites are different.

# Natural beauty in Slovakia

## Geyser in Herľany

It is a rare cold geyser located in Herľany. It is one of the monuments UNESCO. Temperature of water is 14°C-18°C. Its streams are 22 meters high.



# French Festivals

**Bastille Day** is the common name given in English-speaking countries to the national day of France, which is celebrated on **14 July** each year. In French, it is called “la fête nationale”. Celebrations are held throughout France with a lot of fireworks.





# Easter festival - Slovakia

Every year Easter is on a different date.

Boys splash water on girls and they give them decorated eggs.

Water is a symbol of health.



# Endangered species in Slovakia

River otter - it is a mammal adapted to life in the water. It is a species which has been nearly extinct due to fur hunting and pollution. According to estimates, only about 105 river otters live in Slovakia today.





# Endangered species : France

The **Brown Bear** and the **wolf** are found in mountains in France but they are endangered due to hunting by local farmers.



# ***Food and Drink in France***

**France** :Favorite French food is *cheese and bread* and the favorite French drink is the *wine and champagne*.



# Food and drinks - Slovakia

Potato dumplings with sheep cheese and bacon is the Slovak national dish. It's prepared from potatoes, flour, salt, sheep cheese and bacon. We serve it with sour milk.
